



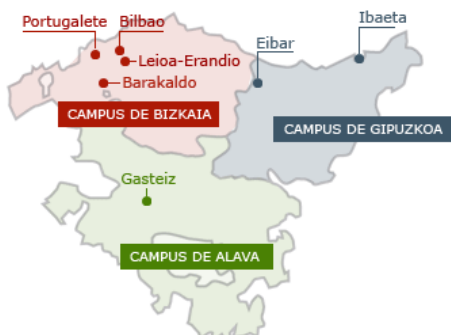

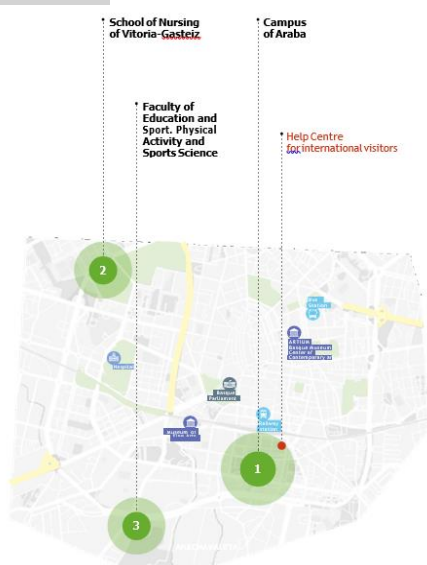

## How to get to Vitoria-Gasteiz

 **The city's airport (called Foronda) is located 9 km from the centre of Vitoria.**

You can take a bus from the bus station or from the city centre (c/Monseñor Cadena y Eleta) to the airport. Approximate travel time: 15 minutes from the bus station, 30 minutes from the centre of Vitoria-Gasteiz.

 **Bilbao airport (Loiu) is the busiest airport in the region.** If you land in Bilbao, you can take a bus from the airport to the city's bus station, TERMIBUS. From TERMIBUS you can travel by bus to Vitoria-Gasteiz. Check timetables at [www.autobuseslaunion.com](http://www.autobuseslaunion.com).

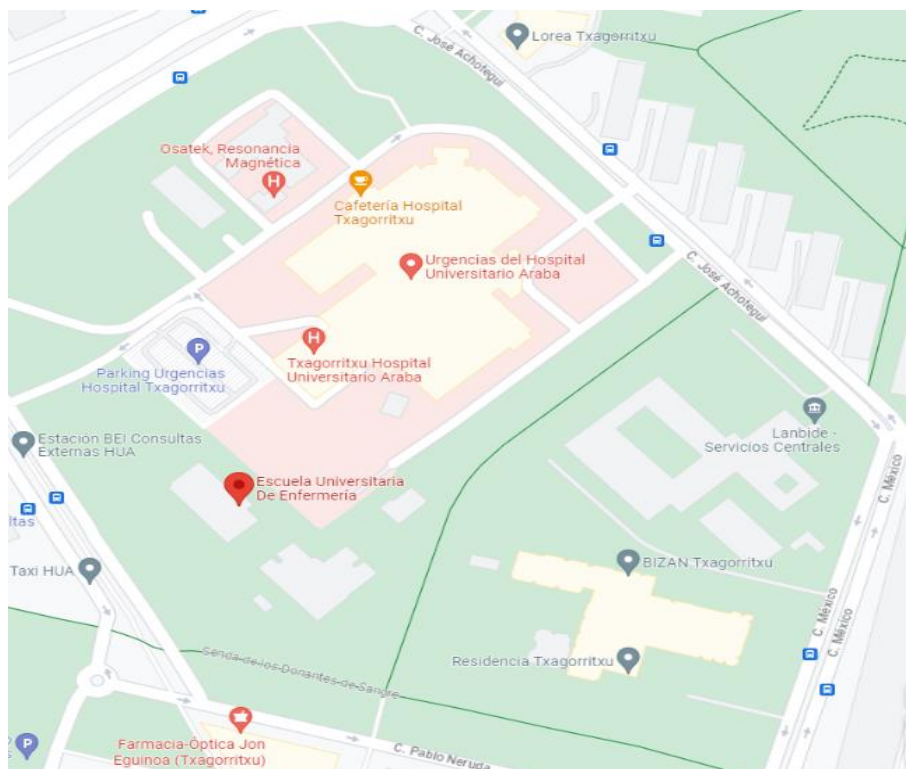

### Email

In the box of "Credencial de acceso" please type your username. Then, in the next webpage type your password in order to login. Lecturers are going to contact you through this e-mail address.



### WiFi - eduroam

Connection to the Universidad del País Vasco / Euskal Herriko Unibertsitatea (UPV/EHU) data network and to the Internet via mobile devices. You can connect your devices to the WiFi hotspot, which is available in every building on Campus of Álava. We suggest using the Eduroam configuration assistant tool "Eduroam CAT"

- The UPV/EHU does not insure visiting students, so they will have to provide a copy of their accident and civil liability insurance.
